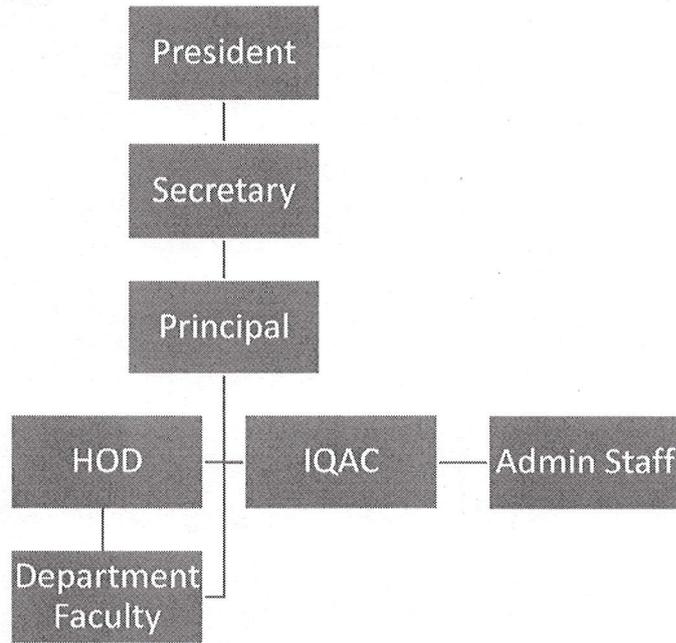


Frequency of the Board Meeting and Academic Advisory Body

Nature and Extent of involvement of Faculty and Students in Academic Affairs/Improvements

Principal, Head of Department and Faculty Members are continuously involved in evolving new strategies to improve the teaching learning process in order to groom students with ability to apply what they learn, believe in life-long learning and commit themselves to work in the best interest of society.

HOD and senior faculty members are responsible for:

- Ensuring overall discipline.
- Maintaining a conducive learning environment.
- Delegate powers to subordinates.
- Nurture the young faculty.
- Build a well-knit team.
- Develop industry contacts.

The institute has various cells/clubs which conduct & organize events and activities that are managed by the students. These cells/clubs lay the perfect platform for healthy interaction between student & faculty members that results in ideas emanating towards the improvement of the Institute

Mechanism/ Norms and Procedure for Democratic/ Good Governance

The management understands the need of decentralized structure for the institute's growth and grants sufficient autonomy to various levels of management. Principal, Heads and Program Coordinators are appointed and granted authority in order to ensure effective governance.

The following tasks and responsibilities of administrators/decision makers for various assigned positions clearly demonstrate the delegation of power, providing operational autonomy, and leading to a decentralised governance structure.

- **Principal:** Responsible for academic development of the institute and monitors progress of various teaching/learning processes
- **Head of the Department:** Responsible for the academic and administrative functions of the department
- **Program Coordinator:** Responsible for the smooth conduct of program

Apart from the above positions registrar, accounts, library etc take care of various support functions with sufficient amount of autonomy.

Student Feedback on Institutional Governance/ Faculty performance

At Allenhouse Business School, student feedback is collected each semester through the ERP portal and class representative meetings to enhance the teaching-learning process.

Faculty are rated on a 1 to 5 scale for each attribute. The data is analyzed, and feedback is shared by the Principal/HOD's. Below-average feedback is reported to the Dean (Academics) via the Academic Cell, who collaborates with HOD's to create and monitor improvement plans, offering training and counselling until progress is evident.

Beyond academics, feedback on facilities — mess, canteen, hygiene, transport, library, and sports — is regularly gathered. Urgent issues are addressed immediately, and corrective actions are communicated to the relevant departments to ensure continuous improvement.

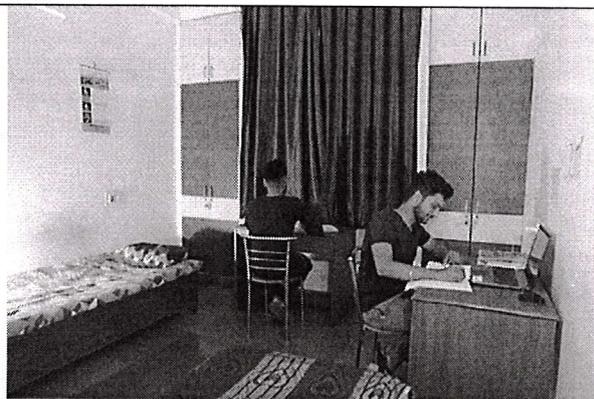
Games & Sports Facilities
